The Texas Department of Banking (Department) is pleased to enclose your renewed MSB license to engage in the business of money transmission in accordance with Chapter 151 of the Texas Finance Code (Finance Code).

As previously communicated to you by the Department, amendments were made to Chapter 151 of the Finance Code that will become effective September 1, 2013. Specifically, under Finance Code §151.207, MSB licenses will no longer expire automatically unless renewed, and the annual report filing deadline is no longer set on August 15th. All other substantive provisions of this section remain unchanged. A license holder will still be required to file an annual report and pay a license fee at a date to be set by the Department, and the consequences of failure to do so would remain the same.
